




SALĀM
The salutation poem – *Muṣṭafā Jan e Rahmāt pe Lakhon Salām* – is perhaps the most widely recited ode in the praise of the Prophet ﷺ after the *Burdah* of Imām Būsirī. One of his lengthiest poems, it is the *Shamāyil* in verse.

KANZ AL-ĪMĀN
Simple, yet stylistic and beautiful, *Kanz* is the most accurate translation of the Qur'ān in Urdu, which conforms to classical tafsirs and faithfully conveys the creed of Ahl al-Sunnah, especially in translation of abstruse verses. It is a word-for-word translation, but still renders figurative expressions and Arabic idioms with admirable skill and grace.

AL-ĀTĀYĀ AN-NABAWIYYAH FI'L FATĀWĀ AR-RIDAWIYYAH
A major collection of fatawa in Hanafi school; rulings are in Urdu, Arabic and Persian. This fatawa collection has fatawa from only 15 years as earlier fatawa were lost. Alahazrat was the mufti's Mufti; an authority towards whom leading scholars of the day turned for answers. In one statistic, 1061 questions out of 4494 were asked by 541 scholars and notables. Fatawa collections are usually in one or two volumes; and by sheer volume only Fatawa al-Hindiyyah comes close and that was compiled by nearly 50 scholars; Fatawa al-Ridawiyyah is the work of just one man.
